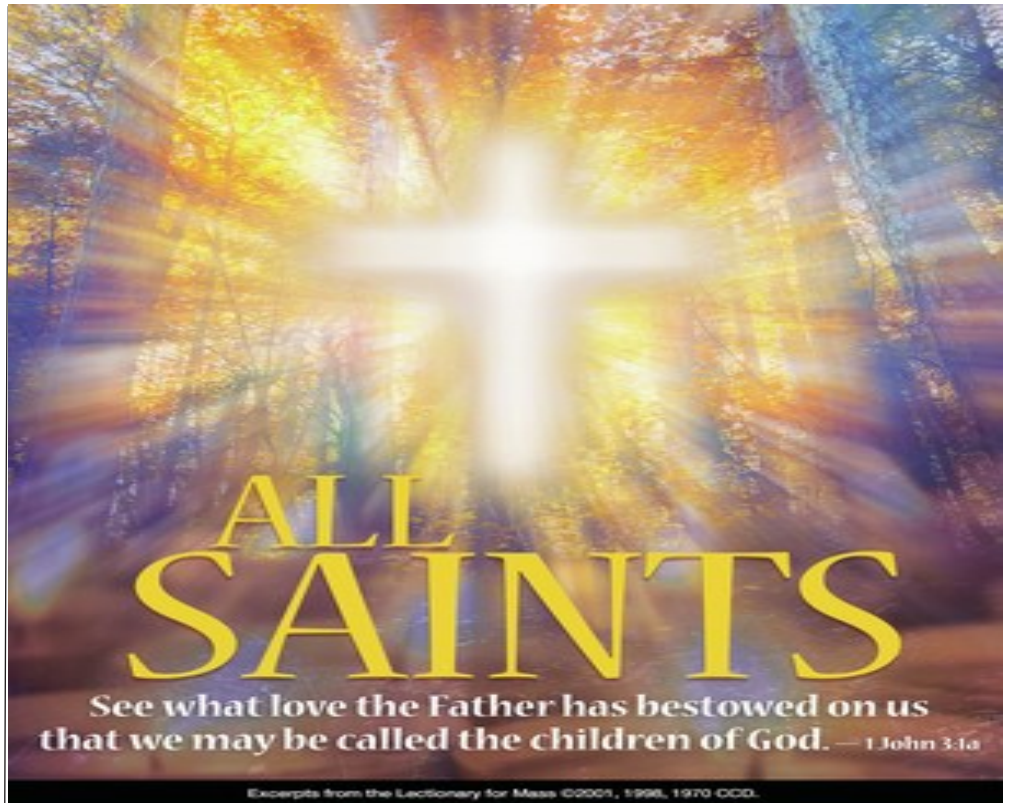

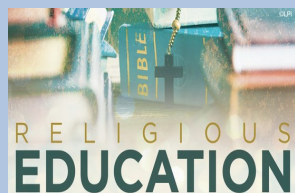
Religious Education & Youth Group News
