MISSION

St. Joseph Catholic Church is a faith community, guided by the scriptures and traditions of the church, whose mission is to share the Good News of Jesus Christ through celebration of the liturgy, sacraments, prayer, faith fellowship, and service to others.

Abiding by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations:

The use of face masks upon entering the church, during the celebration of Mass except when in place in the pew, during the procession, and upon leaving the church is required. If you choose to sing with the choir, your mask should also be worn during that time. Middle School 5th-8th grade will meet on Sunday, December 6th & 13th from 5:00 p.m. to 6:15 p.m.

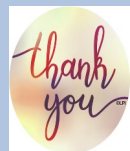


CCD/PSR classes for Pre-K thru 12th grade classes will be in session Sunday, November 22nd from 9:00a.m. to 10:15a.m.

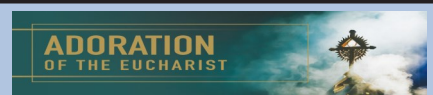
Classes will be in session on Sunday, December 6th, 13th & 20th.

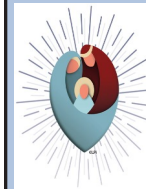
