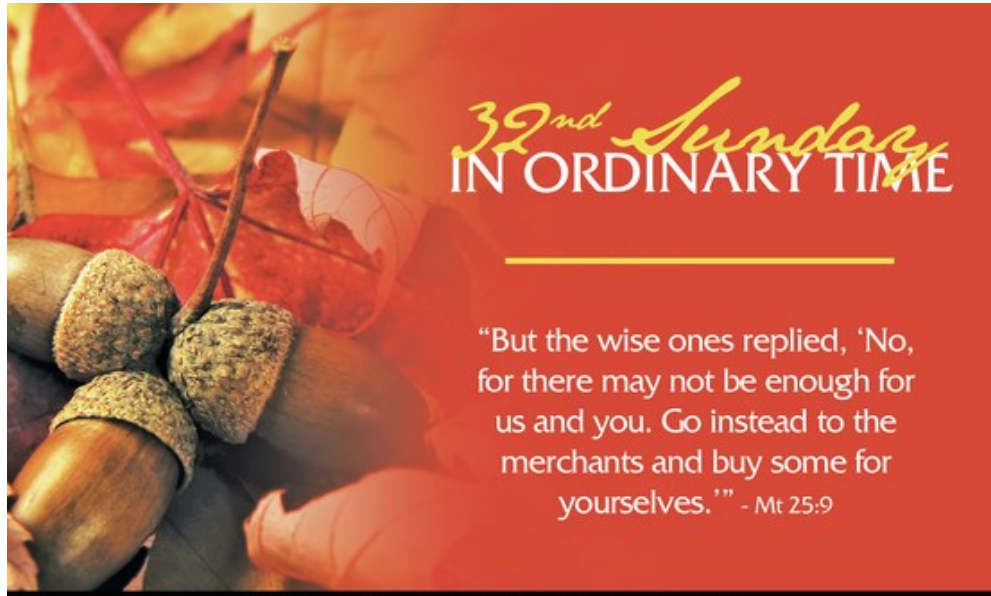

St. Joseph Catholic Church is a faith community, guided by the scriptures and traditions of the church, whose mission is to share the Good News of Jesus Christ through celebration of the liturgy, sacraments, prayer, faith fellowship, and service to others.

**Abiding by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations:**

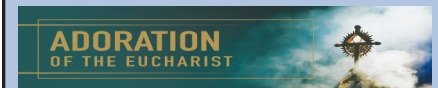
### Upcoming Events at St. Joseph

Tuesday, December 22nd at Farischon hall. Times TBA.

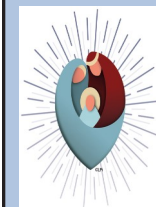
