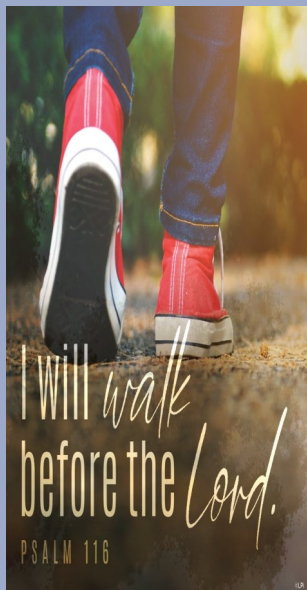

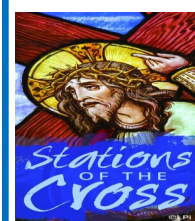
Sacristans and Ministers of Hospitality:
