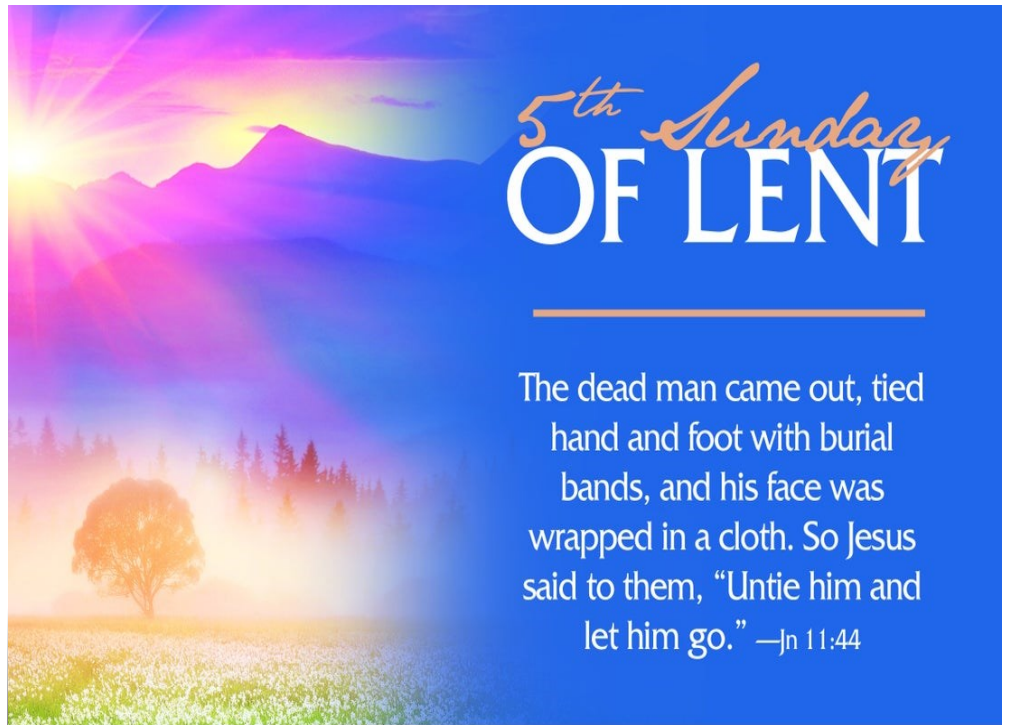

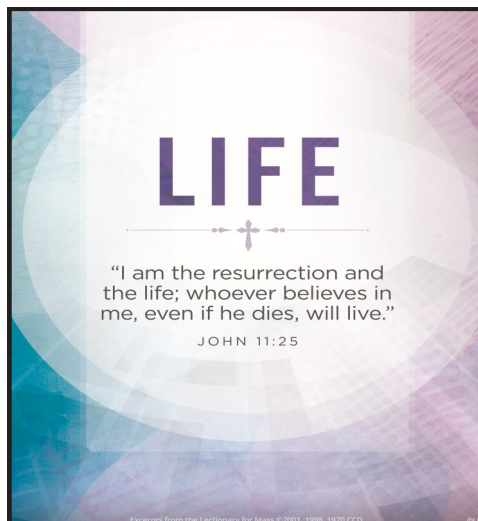
SACRAMENT PREPARATION
