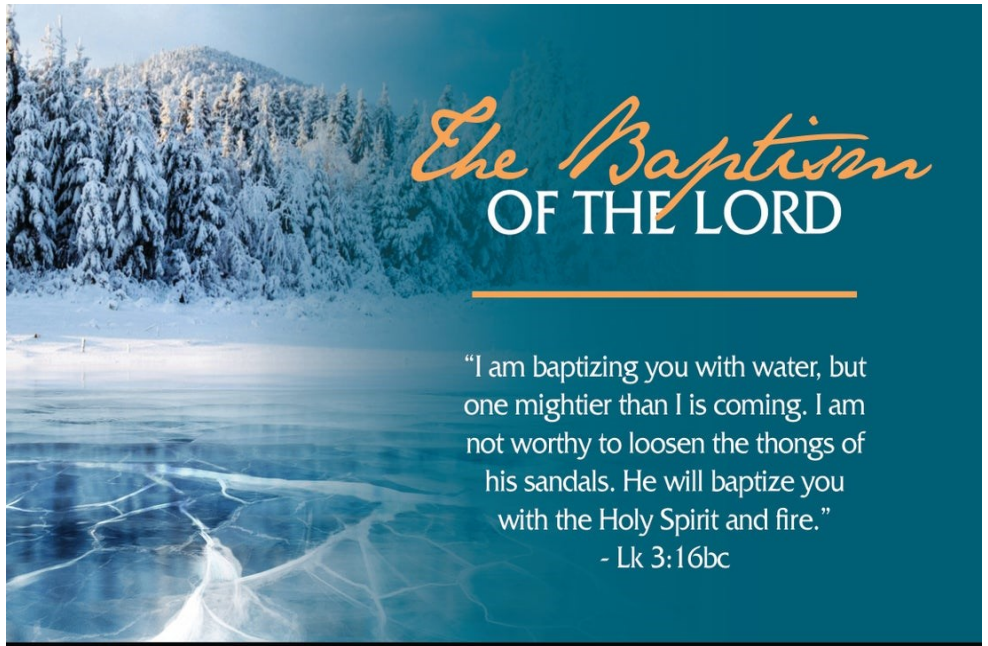

The Baptism of the Lord/January 9, 2022

First Reading: Then the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all people shall see it together; for the mouth of the LORD has spoken. (40:5)

Psalm: O bless the Lord, my soul. (Ps 104)

Second Reading: He saved us through the bath of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit. (Ti 3:5)

Gospel: After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. (Lk 3:22)

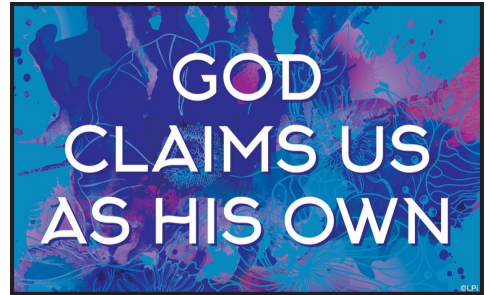
Sacrament Preparation/Celebration

SCHEDULING A MASS INTENTION AT ST. JOSEPH.

Mass intentions will be scheduled only one year in advance; however date requests sometimes will need to be re-scheduled if we have a conflict that happens. (Funeral, Priest out of town, etc.) All Mass requests will need to be scheduled each year through Cathy Fohey at the Parish Office, and anniversary dates **will not** be automatically scheduled from one year to the next. 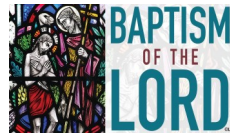
The next Altar Society meeting will take place on February 6th at 8:30 a.m. at Farischon Hall. All ladies of the parish are invited to attend this meeting.
