Coordinate VIRTUS trainings with St. Joseph VIRTUS administrators 3. Have a visible presence in the parish and the community, being a good example of the Catholic faith 4. Work closely with the Pastor/Deacons as well as Education/Formation Committee. 5. Provide monthly reports to the Parish/Stewardship Council regarding activities and plans. 6. Design and schedule youth events, retreats, Confirmation program, community and church service projects, diocesan and national youth events for our parish. 2. Spend time with youth and develop rapport with them. 3. Have a visible presence in the parish and the community, being a good example of the Catholic faith 4.
